DISCOVERY BIBLE STUDY FORMAT

Revised: June 10, 2023

This document provides a simple reproducible format for Discovery Bible Study meetings. Below are goals:

- 1. To glorify God through worship
- 2. To encourage active participation of each individual
- 3. To promote personal interaction in the Word of God
- 4. To obey the commands of Jesus Christ and improve listening to the Holy Spirit
- 5. To promote accountability
- 6. To replicate DBS small groups
- 7. To develop new leaders for those DBS small groups

BEFORE THE D.B.S.:

- 1. WORSHIP: God to set the atmosphere for today's meeting.
- 2. PRAY: for God to engage, establish, equip, and empower disciples.
- 3. ASK: "What have you been thankful for this past week?"
- 4. ASK: "What have you struggled with this past week?"
- 5. ASK: "How could this group help with those struggles?"
- 6. ASK: "What did you learn at the last meeting?"
- 7. ASK: "How did you fulfill your "last assignment" from God?"

DURING THE D.B.S.:

- 8. PRAY: For the Holy Spirit to guide today's Discovery Bible Study.
- 9. READ: Several individuals to READ aloud the passage for today.
- 10. RETELL: Several individuals to RETELL this passage in their own words.
- 11. ASK: "What does this passage say about GOD?"
- 12. ASK: "What does this passage say about PEOPLE?"
- 13. ASK: "What does this passage say about ANGELS?"
- 14. ASK: "What CONTRASTS or COMPARISONS do you see?"
- 15. ASK: "What do you need EXPLAINED from this passage?"
- 16. ASK: "What does this lesson IMPLY about DISCIPLE-MAKING?"
- 17. ASK: "What ASSIGNMENT is God giving you?"
- 18. DECLARE: "This week... with God's help... I will do this... with this individual... in this location..."
- 19. ASK: "With whom should I share what I learned this week?"
- 20. PRAY: For God to help each disciple to fulfill their "assignment" this week!

? AFTER THE DBS **?**

- 21. ASK: When will we meet NEXT TIME?
- 22. ASK: Who could you INVITE to our next meeting?
- 23. ASSIGN: one of the more mature DISCIPLES to lead the next meeting (offering to assist).
- 24. When your group grows, divide the group, and commission a mature leader for this group.

After each meeting, group leaders should re-evaluate progress and adjust future plans. On the next page there is a suggested "Creation to Christ" Scripture reference guide:
